

To Avoid Slow Play

Before the Game

1. Members are to report to the ProShop & collect their card 15 minutes before the start of play.
2. Once members have been called to the tee and they are late, the group in front will be asked to tee off. Members late to the tee will incur a 2 stroke penalty.
3. Respect your fellow players at all times.

During the Game

The average time for Stableford 4 Ball is 4hrs 20 minutes

Average time for Stroke play 4 Ball is 4hrs 45 minutes

To assist in complying with these times:

1. On the tee-allow shorter hitters to hit away when the group ahead is safely out of range. When all players have teed off, get to your ball.
2. If you think your ball may be lost, you must take a provisional.
3. Do not help search before hitting if your ball is nowhere near the player needing help, **hit your ball first.**
4. Always have trolleys in the right position around the green, ready to approach the next tee.
5. When the field is stacking up on the par 3's, mark your ball and call the following group to take tee shots.
6. Around the green-the player first to get to their ball, whether chipping or bunker shot, should communicate to partners and play the shot.
7. On the greens-watch other players lines when reading putt, don't wait until your turn to read the putt. If this is your putt, continue to the hole unless you stand on another player's line.
8. Get to the next tee and if you are teeing off first, mark your card after you have hit off.
9. Be respectful to other course users.
10. Penalties will be applied for slow play and the Match Committee will monitor pace and position of play.
11. All cards must be entered by 5.45pm.
12. Match Committee decision is final.
